The **TranceScience** Research Institute organises the second edition of its Scientific Conference on Auto-Induced Cognitive Trance on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup>, Friday 19<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2026.

This conference is a hybrid event: a limited number of seats are available for in-person attendance, with priority given to clinical and research professionals. The entire conference will also be accessible remotely on digital, with a progressive fee dependent on the number of days of access.

This event brings together researchers and clinicians engaged in research on AICT and its applications. The aim of these three days is to promote the sharing of results and discussions regarding projects and research perspectives on the mechanisms, effects, and potential applications of AICT. Speakers at this conference will present their work and research perspectives through presentations organised into several thematic sessions, such as:

- AICT, voice, creativity
- Phenomenology of the AICT state
- Pilot studies and clinical perspectives
- Tools and methodological frameworks for the study of AICT
- Philosophical and anthropological perspectives on trance states
